Spring 2025 Update: Beaver River Bridge Replacement Project

The Beaver River Bridge replacement project on the PA Turnpike is more than halfway complete, with significant progress on constructing the new bridges and reconfiguring the interchange. The project is on track for the westbound bridge to open in mid-2026 and the entire project to be finished by 2027.

Currently, construction is focused on building the new bridge over the Beaver River and expanding the roadway to three lanes in each direction. The westbound bridge structure is anticipated to open in mid-2026, while the eastbound bridge is still under construction.

Two key milestones are also underway. The WB 209 (I-76 over SR 0018) overpass in the ramp JK interchange is installing rebar and will begin deck placement by mid-2025. Traffic on and off the PA Turnpike is in temporary ramp configurations, so please use caution driving through the construction zone. In addition, the mainline bridges over the Beaver River are being built with significant progress on the piers and segments.

Overall, the project is on track, and we look forward to continued progress in the coming months.
