Project Description

Allegheny and Butler Counties, PA

The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission (PTC) has scheduled an Open House Plans Display to update the public on the \$76 million total reconstruction project on the PTC mainline between the Cranberry Interchange (Milepost 28) in Butler County and the Warrendale Toll Plaza (Milepost 31) in Allegheny County. The project, located in Cranberry and Marshall Townships, will include the widening of the existing Turnpike roadway from four (4) lanes and a 10 ft. median to six (6) lanes and a 26 ft. median.

This reconstruction and widening project also includes:

- The replacement of three (3) PTC mainline bridges,
- The extension of one (1) culvert,
- The lowering of T-478 (Mt. Pleasant Road),
- The construction of new stormwater facilities, and
- The construction of a new sound wall and retaining wall.
