Planned Construction Activities for the Week of May 19, 2025

# SECTION 53A1 • JEFFERSON HILLS BOROUGH, ALLEGHENY COUNTY

## 1. Work Shift

 The standard work shift is 6:00 AM to 4:30 PM, Monday to Thursday. Friday and Saturday shifts will be used as needed. Some work may be limited due to wet weather.

## 2. Traffic

- <u>Coal Valley Road</u> Coal Valley Road is scheduled to close again May 27, 2025 for up to two months for road reconstruction.
- <u>SR 885 Clairton Road</u> There will be construction traffic and deliveries in this area.

- <u>Jefferson Boulevard/SR 51</u> A new traffic pattern is implemented. Follow traffic signs, arrows, merging areas, stop signs and obey speed limits.
- Brickyard Road will have traffic restrictions during working hours.
- <u>Pitt McKeesport Boulevard</u> A single-lane closure is in place on Pittsburgh McKeesport Boulevard for the future 53B1A construction section and plugging two existing gas wells.

## 3. Roadway and Bridge Work

- <u>Bridge 400/401 over Brickyard Rd/SR 51/Peters Creek</u> Concrete bridge deck placements are ongoing and scheduled as weather permits. Southbound deck placements have been completed. Bridge parapet work underway.
- <u>Bridge 402 over Jefferson Boulevard</u> Majority of work is completed. Bridge parapets to be stained.
- <u>Bridge 403 SR 885 over 43</u> Roadway and bridge open to traffic. Work continues under bridge on articulated slopes and curbs.
- <u>Bridge 404/405 over Coal Valley</u> Deck forms, overhang work and rebar installation underway.
  Concrete deck placements on the 405 Southbound bridge have started.

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- <u>Toll Facility</u> Toll facility building is being constructed. Roofing and interior work started.
- <u>Jefferson Boulevard</u> Traffic is in a temporary configuration until the PTC 43 northbound off ramp is reopened in Spring 2025. The Payne Hill Road entrance is open to public traffic.
- 43 Northbound Ramp and Mainline All traffic crossed over to southbound side. Concrete paving has started back up as weather permits.

#### 4. Noise/Dust/Runoff Control

- Erosion control measures are installed and will be modified as construction advances.
   The erosion controls will be maintained as necessary.
- Diversion ditches have been constructed to take runoff water to sediment basins.
- Sediment basins hold water for settlement and slow dispersion. Will be converted to storm water detention basins at end of project.
- A street sweeper is on-site and will be used clean local roadways when needed.
- Water trucks are on-site and will be utilized to control dust when needed.

## 5. Trespassing on Construction Site

- The construction being performed in this area is a Limited Access Right-of-Way owned by the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission. The construction areas are posted with No Trespassing/ Private Property signs. No pedestrians, ATVs or motorcycles should be entering the area.
- Violators may be prosecuted under Section 3503(b)(1)(ii) which forbids criminal trespass.
