Construction Activity Weekly Updates



Planned Construction Activities for the Week of June 15, 2026

SECTION 53B1A

WEST MIFFLIN/DRAVOSBURG, ALLEGHENY COUNTY

1. Work Shift

- The standard work shift is 6:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday to Thursday. Friday and Saturday shifts will be used as needed.

2. Traffic

- **Camp Hollow Road** – Construction traffic will enter and exit Camp Hollow near the new roundabouts.
- **Curry Hollow Road** – Some deliveries and construction traffic will be via Curry Hollow Road near the WMSSA Pump Station.
- **Pitt McKeesport Boulevard / Richland Avenue** – Construction traffic will enter and exit construction site at existing entrance on Pitt McKeesport Boulevard. Traffic shifting will be occurring in preparation for long term construction stages and waterline tie in.

3. Roadway and Bridge Work

- Sediment basin construction is ongoing.
- Shoring and excavation for 411A/B Pier 3 and Pier 4 foundations along Curry Hollow.
- Shoring and excavation for 413D Abutment 2 at Pitt McKeesport.
- Stockpiling quarry rock for future embankment construction.
- Constructing toe keys to support future embankments.
- Diverting water from Sandy Lake Area around construction areas.

4. Noise/Dust/Runoff Control

- Erosion control measures are installed and will be modified as construction advances. The erosion controls will be maintained as necessary.
- Diversion ditches have been constructed to take runoff water to sediment basins.
- Sediment basins hold water for settlement and slow dispersion.

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- A street sweeper is on-site and will be used clean local roadways when needed.
- Water trucks are on-site and will be utilized to control dust when needed.

5. Trespassing on Construction Site

- The construction being performed in this area is a Limited Access Right-of-Way owned by the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission. The construction areas are posted with No Trespassing/Private Property signs. **No pedestrians, ATVs or motorcycles should be entering the area.**
- Violators may be prosecuted under Section 3503(b)(1)(ii) which forbids criminal trespass.
