Portion of New England Road in West Mifflin Borough, Allegheny County to Close
Extended closure needed for construction work related to the Mon/Fayette Expressway Project.

The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission wants to alert motorists that a portion of New England Road in West Mifflin Borough, Allegheny County will be closed for approximately two months beginning May 26.

New England Road will be closed between Camp Hollow Road and Coal Valley Road as crews continue constructing the Mon/Fayette Expressway and perform drainage reconstruction.

The official detour is about 8.4 miles utilizing Camp Hollow Road and will be posted.

New England Road is expected to reopen July 25. This will be the final closure of New England Road as construction wraps up this fall.
