Temporary Closure of Camp Hollow Road in West Mifflin Borough, Allegheny County

Closure needed for work related to the Mon/Fayette Expressway Project.

The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission wants to alert motorists traveling a portion of Camp Hollow Road (S.R. 2043) in West Mifflin Borough, Allegheny County, they will need to use a short detour beginning Oct. 10.

Camp Hollow Road will be closed in both directions between the intersection with Phillip Murray Road and the intersection with New England Road. The entrance to US Steel Irvin Works will not be affected.

The closure will last approximately 48 days with plans to reopen before the Thanksgiving holiday. Traffic signs will be posted.

During the closure, crews will be erecting steel structures for the future bridges being built as part of the Mon/Fayette Expressway Project. For more information about the project, please visit: https://www.patpconstruction.com/monfaysb/default.aspx.
