Camp Hollow Road in West Mifflin Borough, Allegheny County Sees Traffic Switch Change needed to finish roundabout on Camp Hollow Road related to the Mon/Fayette Expressway Project.

The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission wants to alert motorists that a portion of Camp Hollow Road (S.R. 2043) in West Mifflin Borough, Allegheny County will be switching to a new configuration as crews finish working on the roundabout just north of the Lebanon School Road intersection.

Vehicles traveling northbound on Camp Hollow Road will be pushed to the new roundabout system starting July 22.

Southbound traffic coming from Lebanon Church Road will remain in its current configuration.

Southbound traffic wanting to access Lebanon School Road will need to use the posted detour route.

Northbound traffic traveling to Lebanon Manor Drive, Beverly Drive and Linda Lane will need to use the temporary connector road until work is completed.

The entire roundabout is expected to be finished during the first week of August when both northbound and southbound traffic will travel the new roundabout configuration.
