Traffic Changes Coming to Camp Hollow Road in West Mifflin Borough, Allegheny County

Restrictions needed to finish work related to the Mon/Fayette Expressway Project.

The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission wants to alert motorists traveling a portion of Camp Hollow Road (S.R. 2043) in West Mifflin Borough, Allegheny County, of a new traffic pattern and detour beginning Aug. 2.

Southbound traffic traveling from Lebanon Church Road will be using the new roundabout.

Beverly Drive will be closed to thru traffic, but local residential traffic may use the posted detour.

Residential traffic traveling southbound on Camp Hollow Road to Beverly Drive, Lebanon Manor and homes in between will need to make a right turn using the temporary connector road to turn around just before Lebanon School Road and head north to Camp Hollow Road.

All other traffic heading northbound will use the new roundabout.

Southbound traffic heading to Lebanon School Road will now be able to make the left turn directly onto the roadway. Traffic signs will be posted.

This traffic pattern is expected to be in place for approximately two weeks.
