Coal Valley Road in Jefferson Hills Borough, Allegheny County to Close Two-month closure needed for construction of PA Turnpike's Mon/Fayette Expressway Project.

The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission is alerting motorists a section of Coal Valley Road that runs through Jefferson Hills Borough and into the City of Clairton, Allegheny County will be closed for approximately two months beginning May 27.

Coal Valley Road will be closed between state routes 837 and 885 (Clairton Road). A nearly four-mile detour will be in place through Jefferson Hills Borough and Clairton.

Depending on weather conditions, Coal Valley Road should be reopened in early August.

During the closure, crews will be reconstructing Coal Valley Road around the new overhead bridges as part of the PA Turnpike's southern section of the Mon/Fayette Expressway PA Route 51 to I-376 Project.
