Portion of Miller Road in Jefferson Hills Borough, Allegheny County to Close

Closure needed as part of PA Turnpike's Mon/Fayette Expressway Project.

The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission wants to alert motorists that approximately one mile of Miller Road in Jefferson Hills Borough, Allegheny County will be permanently closed beginning at 7 a.m. on April 3 as part of the construction of the Mon/Fayette Expressway (PA Turnpike 43).

The portion of Miller Road between the intersection with State Route 885 (Clairton Road) and the intersection with State Route 837 (North State Street) will permanently be closed. Cul-de-sacs will eventually be constructed at each end of the closure for permanent turn-around points.

Traffic will now need to use State Route 837 and State Route 885 as alternate routes.

This traffic impact is part of the Mon/Fayette Expressway PA Route 51 to I-376 Project's 53A1 construction section. For more information about the project, please visit:
