Weekend Closures Planned for S.R. 51 in Jefferson Hills Borough, Allegheny County

Two closures needed for bridge beam installation for Mon/Fayette Expressway Project.

The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission (PTC) wants to alert motorists that a portion of State Route 51 in Jefferson Hills Borough, Allegheny County will be closed in both directions starting August 23 at 10 p.m. until August 26 at 5 a.m.

This closure will be in effect from Worthington Ave. to Peters Creek Road with a posted detour and traffic controls in place.

During this time, crews will be installing overhead beams for the bridge that will carry traffic on the Mon/Fayette Expressway (PA Turnpike 43) over State Route 51.

A second, full weekend closure will occur in the same location at the same times from September 6 to September 9 to install additional bridge beams.

This work is weather dependent, so it may be postponed if inclement conditions occur. The alternate date for this work would be September 13 to September 16.
