More Restrictions Planned for S.R. 51 in Jefferson Hills Borough, Allegheny County

Lane restrictions needed for sign installations as part of the Mon/Fayette Expressway Project.

The Pennsylvania Turnpike (PA Turnpike) wants to advise motorists that single lane closures will be taking place along State Route 51 (S.R. 51) in Jefferson Hills Borough, Allegheny County beginning April 13.

The single lane closures will happen both northbound and southbound from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. to allow crews to install overhead sign structures.

Drivers traveling southbound will be directed into the median turning lane between Coal Valley Road and Jefferson Boulevard allowing a single lane of traffic through this area.

Drivers heading northbound will use a single travel lane in front of the Huntington Bank and then be directed back to the turning lane prior to Jefferson Boulevard allowing traffic to turn onto the roadway.

This work will be completed by May 1.
