Lane restrictions planned on State Route 22 in Allegheny and Washington counties

Restrictions needed to install guiderail as part of Southern Beltway Project.

The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission wants to alert motorists that lane restrictions on State Route 22 may be in place from May 17 through June 25 when crews will be installing guiderail in both Allegheny and Washington counties.

In Robinson Township, Washington County, single-lane restrictions could be in effect in both directions about a half mile east of the Maple Grove Road overpass near the intersection with Campbell Road.

In North Fayette Township, Allegheny County, single-lane restrictions could be in place near the Steubenville Pike Crossing.

This work is dependent on the weather, and would take place between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.
