Temporary closure of Fort Cherry Connector Road Planned
Six-week closure needed as part of PA Turnpike's Southern Beltway Project.

The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission is alerting motorists that the newly built Fort Cherry Connector Road in Robinson Township, Washington County will be closed daily beginning August 24.

Monday through Thursday, from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m., the Fort Cherry Connector Road will be closed to traffic between Noblestown Road and State Route 980. Drivers will be able to use Noblestown Road as an alternate route.

This work is expected to last approximately six weeks while crews finish erosion and sediment work on the slopes adjacent to the roadway.

Emergency vehicles will still have access to the connector road.
