**Traffic Restrictions Planned in McDonald Borough and Cecil Township,
Washington County**

*Five-week closure on Johns Avenue needed for drainage work as part of PA Turnpike's S.R. 980
Drainage Improvement Project.*

The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission is alerting motorists that traffic will be restricted on Johns Avenue in McDonald Borough and Cecil Township, Washington County beginning Oct. 10 for five weeks.

Johns Avenue (State Route 4012) will be closed between Noblestown Road (State Route 4027) and State Route 980. A posted, 1.8-mile detour will be in place directing traffic onto Noblestown Road. Local traffic will be able to access Johns Avenue from Noblestown Road.

The closure is needed for crews to relocate a 24-inch water line and install a new 66-inch drainage pipe across Johns Avenue near its intersection with State Route 980. This closure will be in effect through Nov. 18.
