Traffic Restrictions Planned in McDonald Borough and Cecil Township, Washington County

Four-week closure needed for section of Johns Avenue as part of PA Turnpike's S.R. 980 Drainage Improvement Project.

Traffic restrictions will be in place on Johns Avenue (State Route 4012) in McDonald Borough and Cecil Township, Washington County beginning April 3 as part of the PA Turnpike Commission's State Route 980 Drainage Improvement Project.

Johns Avenue will be closed between Noblestown Road (State Route 4027) and State Route 980 through May 1.

Those living within this closed section of Johns Avenue will be able to access the area, but all other traffic will need to use the posted detour. The nearly two-mile detour will be in place directing drivers to use Noblestown Road.

This closure is needed for crews to relocate a 24-inch water line and perform roadway pavement repairs to Johns Avenue near its intersection with State Route 980.
