- 1. Work Shift
  - Work shifts will be Tuesday through Friday 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. and 5 p.m. to 3 a.m.
- 2. Traffic
  - Reminder Construction activities may be occurring anywhere within the project limits at any time and can be hazardous. Please do not enter the work area on foot, on a bicycle or in a vehicle at any time, as it is unsafe to do so.
  - Reminder The speed limit on I-79 in the work zone is 45 mph. This is for the safety of the traveling public as well as the workers. A work zone speed enforcement camera will be used on I-79 through the work zone.
  - Southbound traffic on I-79 has two lanes of traffic. All traffic exiting at the Southpointe exit will need to be in the right-hand lane in advance of the exit.
  - Traffic is now open on the new PA Turnpike 576 westbound from I-79 northbound and on PA Turnpike 576 eastbound to I-79 southbound.
  - Traffic is now open from Morganza Road to I-79 northbound with the opening of Ramp MR\_D and Ramp 0576W\_79N.
  - Two lanes of traffic each way will be maintained during daytime hours on I-79.
    Night restrictions may reduce traffic to one lane each way from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m.
  - Construction traffic will use I-79, PA Turnpike 576 and Morganza Road to access the site.
  - Shoulder closures will be in place on Southpointe Boulevard under I-79 to accommodate work on the bridge.

## 3. Earthwork

- Primary, bulk earthwork has been completed on the project. Small, localized earthwork will continue to finalize grades throughout the project site.
- Blasting activities for the site are completed.

#### 4. Roadway and Bridge Work

- Concrete paving operations continue on ramps and the new mainline throughout the project.
- Crews are working in the median of I-79 to place concrete pavement.

SOUTHERN BELTWAY CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY WEEKLY UPDATE

- Drainage lines are being installed for new roadway drainage throughout the project.
- Construction will be ongoing for widening of the bridge carrying I-79 southbound over Southpointe Boulevard.
- Slope protection and shoulder backup are being installed throughout the site adjacent to ramps and new mainline roadway.

## 5. Gas/Oil Wells

## 6. Noise/Dust/Runoff Control

- A street sweeper is on-site and will be deployed to clean public roads as needed.
- Erosion and sedimentation control measures are being installed and maintained as the project advances.
- Water trucks will be used as needed to minimize dust from construction activities.

## 7. Night Work Activities

 Shoulder backup, rock armor installation and slope tracking may occur along I-79. Work will occur Tuesday through Friday from 5 p.m. to 3 a.m.
