1. Work Shift

• Work shifts will be Monday through Friday 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. and 5 p.m. to 3 a.m.

2. Traffic

- Reminder Construction activities may be occurring anywhere within the project limits at any time and can be hazardous. Please do not enter the work area on foot, on a bicycle or in a vehicle at any time, as it is unsafe to do so.
- Reminder The speed limit on I-79 in the work zone is 45 mph. This is for the safety of the traveling public as well as the workers. A work zone speed enforcement camera will be used on I-79 through the work zone.
- Southbound traffic on I-79 has two lanes of traffic. All traffic exiting at the Southpointe exit will need to be in the right-hand lane in advance of the exit.
- The Turnpike 576 / I-79 interchange was opened on Friday, June 24, 2022. Turnpike 576 and all ramps to and from I-79 are now open to public traffic.
- Two lanes of traffic each way will be maintained during daytime hours on I-79. Night restrictions may reduce traffic to one lane each way from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Construction traffic will use I-79, PA Turnpike 576 and Morganza Road to access the site.

3. Earthwork

- Primary, bulk earthwork has been completed on the project. Small, localized earthwork will continue to finalize grades throughout the project site.
- Blasting activities for the site are completed.
- The contractor will continue placing topsoil, seeding and mulch blanketing on slopes throughout the project.

4. Roadway and Bridge Work

- Placement of concrete at median barrier at I-79.
- Placement of R-4 Material behind the median barrier at I-79.
- Completion of punch list items at PA Turnpike 576, I-79, Ramp 79S_576E, Ramp 576E_79N, and Ramp 576W_79S.
- Contractor will be installing concrete barrier at Ramp 79S 576E.
- Contractor will be performing joint saw cutting and sealing at I-79.



SOUTHERN BELTWAY CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY WEEKLY UPDATE

- Contractor will be performing traffic marking painting at I-79.
- Contractor will be removing temporary concrete barrier at I-79.
- Contractor will be installing a light pole at Ramp 576W 79N.
- Project-wide stormwater management pond conversion work will continue.
- Right-of-way fence is being installed over the entire project area.
- Slope protection is being installed throughout the site adjacent to ramps and new mainline roadway.

5. Gas/Oil Wells

There is no gas/oil well work at this time.

6. Noise/Dust/Runoff Control

- A street sweeper is on-site and will be deployed to clean public roads as needed.
- Erosion and sedimentation control measures are being installed and maintained as the project advances.
- Water trucks will be used as needed to minimize dust from construction activities.

7. Night Work Activities


