1. Work Shift

• Work shifts will be Monday through Friday 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. and 5 p.m. to 3 a.m.

2. Traffic

- Reminder Construction activities may be occurring anywhere within the project limits at any time and can be hazardous. Please do not enter the work area on foot, on a bicycle or in a vehicle at any time, as it is unsafe to do so.
- Reminder The speed limit on I-79 in the work zone is 45 mph. This is for the safety of the traveling public as well as the workers. A work zone speed enforcement camera will be used on I-79 through the work zone.
- Punchlist work on I-79 will continue throughout the project.
- A single lane restriction will be taking place in the southbound lanes of I-79 this weekend to perform pavement repair work.
- The speed limit and construction signs along I-79 are tentatively scheduled to be taken down by 10/15/2022.
- Night restrictions may reduce traffic to one lane each way from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Construction traffic will use I-79, PA Turnpike 576 and Morganza Road to access the site.

3. Earthwork

- Primary, bulk earthwork has been completed on the project. Small, localized earthwork will continue to finalize grades throughout the project site.
- Blasting activities for the site are completed.
- The contractor will continue placing topsoil, seeding and mulch blanketing on slopes throughout the project.

4. Roadway and Bridge Work

- Completion of punch list items at PA Turnpike 576, I-79, Ramp 79S_576E, Ramp 576E_79N, and Ramp 576W_79S.
- Contractor will be restoring the concrete batch site.
- Contractor will be restoring the office location site.
- Project-wide stormwater management pond conversion work will continue.
- Right-of-way fence is being installed over the entire project area.

5. Noise/Dust/Runoff Control

- A street sweeper is on-site and will be deployed to clean public roads as needed.
- Erosion and sedimentation control measures are being installed and maintained as the project advances.

 Topsoil placement, slope tracking, general cleanup work, and pond conversion activities along I-79 and PA Turnpike 576. Work will occur Monday through Friday from 5 p.m. to 3 a.m.
